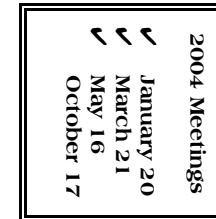

**Preserving Our Past** - One of the major purposes of the Athens Historical Society is to not only collect and preserve materials of historic interest about Athens and Clarke County, but to disseminate this knowledge for the use of others, to stimulate public interest in and appreciation of the history of our area. We have published transcriptions of the Oconee Hill Cemetery (1971) and a volume of over 130 church and family burying grounds in 1999. An new edition of the 1971 volume, annotated with information from many sources, is in the works.

At the May meeting of the AHS Board, a new committee was formed to coordinate with other interested groups on the publication of the records of the **historic Gospel Pilgrim Cemetery** in Athens.
